At the Annual Meeting, Joy had asked me to put out another
 request for servers on Sundays at Worship. The more we
 have, the better. There is something for everyone! Please let
 me know (or you can contact Joy @ 605-255-4212) if you
 would like to serve!

Assisting Minister: This person will help lead worship by
 reading scripture, prayers and other parts of the service as
 they desire. They will also check-in with the Pastor before
 worship to see if they need assistance with anything.

Greeters/Ushers: Greeters will greet people as they enter the
 church while passing out bulletins. Ushers will assist with
 seating people before worship and dismissing at the end of
 service. Lighting altar candles are also part of the duties.

Broadcasting/Sound System: Don't be afraid! This is a
 very easy job, thanks to our new system! This person will
 turn on the sound system and start/stop the
 livestream. Pastor Deb will train you.

Communion Prep: These people will fill individual
 communion cups and bring all the elements upstairs. They
 will make sure the bread and wine are on the altar for the
 Pastor and assistant giving communion elements trays to
 worshippers. Putting elements away after worship is the
 final task.

Communion Assist: Offers the wine/grape juice saying "The
 Blood of Christ, shed for you."

Fellowship Host/Hostess: Two or more people are needed
 for this position each week. They are responsible for setting
 up for fellowship, serving and cleaning up. Crackers, meat
 and cheese (as well as all paper products) are provided by
 the church.
