In the wilderness, the people become impatient and begin to lose their faith and trust in God. RINGING OF THE BELL

CALL TO WORSHIP

The people of Israel wander in the desert, becoming more irritable with every step, and complain against God and Moses.

"Why did you bring us out here to die? Back in Egypt, we at least had water and food. Here there's nothing. We can't take this much longer."

So God uses serpents to punish the complaining, untrusting Israelites. Many people are dying from snakebites, so the people come to Moses and say:

"We sinned when we spoke out against you and God. Pray to God and ask God to take the snakes away."

So Moses prays, and God tells him to make a snake and put it on a pole, and whoever is bitten and looks at the pole will live.

Moses obeys God, makes a snake on a pole, and the people of Israel live. This God is our God, as well: a Three-in-One God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Amen.

SCRIPTURE READING

Genesis 17:1-7, 15-16

⁴From Mount Hor [the Israelites] set out by the way to the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; but the people became impatient on the way. ⁵The people spoke against God and against Moses, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and we detest this miserable food." ⁶Then the LORD sent poisonous serpents among the people, and they bit the people, so that many Israelites died. ⁷The people came to Moses and said, "We have sinned by speaking against the LORD and against you; pray to the LORD to take away the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people. ⁸And the LORD said to Moses, "Make a poisonous serpent, and set it on a pole; and everyone who is bitten shall look at it and live." ⁹So Moses made a serpent of bronze, and put it upon a pole; and whenever a serpent bit someone, that person would look at the serpent of bronze and live.

LuMin: The Hills, under the direction of Rachel Nelson, offers post-secondary students opportunities for community, service, fellowship, discipleship, worship, and Bible study at The Luther House in Rapid City and The Living Room in Spearfish. In the last couple of years and in the midst of the pandemic, this ministry has expanded to post-secondary schools beyond just Mines & BH. Students from SDSU Nursing, USD Nursing, WDT, Mines and BH now participate in LuMin activities, building relationships and deepening faith. Rachel has been finding out-of-the box ways during the pandemic to continue to build relationships and deepen faith among students and their families for those who have children.
